2. In a town 4320 man, 3825 women and 1872 children live. How many people live in the town?
3. A chocolate factory produce 24780 milk chocolates on first day, 22645 candy on second day and 18874 coconut chocolate on third day. How many chocolates did the factory produce?
4. John travelled 657 km on day one, 677 km on day two and 702 on day three. How much distance John travelled in total?
5. A library has 2495 mathematics books, 1972 science book, 2134 English books and 778 history books.
What is the total number books available in the library?
6. Ryan read four books. The books contained 547, 439, 784 and 509. How many pages did he read in total?
7. There are five bags of mangoes. The first bag contains 258 mangoes, second bag contains 432 mangoes, third bags contains 389 mangoes, fourth bags contains 366 and fifth bag contains 249 mangoes. What is the total number of mangoes in all the five bags?
8. A factory makes 5012, 1018 and 4526 cricket balls on three different days. How many cricket balls are made in these three days?
9. 342 persons visited a museum on Monday, 786 persons visited on Tuesday, 1020 persons visited on Wednesday and 674 persons visited on Thursday. How many persons in total visited the museum in four days?
10. In a stockyard there are 558 bags of rice, 945 bags of wheat and 950 bags of pulses. How many bags of grains are there in the stockyard?
